It was resolved to set the precept at £40,850 and approve the budget with a net expenditure of £47,957.47. The remainder of the budget will be financed out of council reserves. This is to limit the increase to council tax to 3% and with the expectation that the tax base will increase more from 2023/24, allowing a larger precept to be set in future without a corresponding increase in council tax. The tax base will increase with the occupation of the new houses being built.
